

### **BREAKING GROUND**

In 2021, PCH made significant progress on our **Home Means Hope Campaign**. Working with PCH's closest supporters, we raised funds to build 25 new homes and make neighborhood improvements at Princeton Community Village (PCV) – a community developed and managed by PCH.

On October 15, 2021, members of our staff, board, and the Princeton community, including members of the PCV resident advisory committee, participated in a groundbreaking ceremony to commemorate the beginning of the construction. To be mindful of the pandemic, the outdoor ceremony was recorded and made available through PCH's website.

When completed, the new three-story building will have a mix of one-, two-, and three-bedroom apartments for very low-, low-, and moderate-income households. The construction meets or exceeds Enterprise Green energy efficiency standards. It will include enhancements to the existing neighborhood such as improvements to the Ted Vial clubhouse; an outdoor pavilion; electric vehicle charging stations; bicycle racks; a package pickup center; underground storm water management; and native landscaping including trees, shrubs, and rain garden plantings.



### THE PCH DIFFERENCE

The adverse impact that Covid-19 has had on working-class families continued in 2021. Our Social Services Coordinators and community partners continued to work with residents and organized resources to help our neighbors meet their basic needs.

PCH's Coronavirus Emergency Rent Relief Fund (CERF) provided direct support for our residents. Funds for this program came through grants and individual donations. PCH also raised money for CERF through our first virtual event in February 2021 - a virtual conversation with Dr. Eddie Glaude Jr. and Rev. Lukata Mjumbe, pastor of the Witherspoon Street Presbyterian Church. Dr. Glaude and Rev. Mjumbe spoke about the writer and activist James Baldwin, as well as how to further social and moral justice both in Princeton and at large.

Ensuring that our homes are not only affordable but safe and well-maintained is a part of our mission. PCH's maintenance staff continued to take safety precautions in 2021 to schedule and make repairs and improvements to residents' homes. Larger necessary upgrades were also made at PCH's communities including modernizing the elevators at Elm Court and Princeton Community Village.

### **AN EARLY START**

Recognizing the need for accessible early childhood education led to a new program at Princeton Community Village (PCV).

Princeton Public Schools and Princeton YMCA partnered with PCH to open the school district's sixth free public preschool program at the Crimmins Learning Center at PCV. This program expanded the use of the Crimmins Learning Center where the YMCA has operated the Princeton Young Achievers after-school program since 2011.

"We immediately embraced the idea. This is a wonderful feature to have in the community, especially with the pandemic. It's part of Princeton Community Housing's mission to not just provide welcoming and affordable homes, but also provide support so that people can succeed. ### **ACCESS TO EDUCATION**

Despite the challenges of the pandemic, college students living at PCV continued to pursue their undergraduate studies. In August of 2021, PCH had the opportunity to publicly honor eight of these students who were awarded a total of over \$52,000 in college scholarships. Earlier that year, with the support of PCH staff, these students had successfully applied for these competitive scholarships available through the National Affordable Housing Management Association (NAHMA) and the New Jersey Affordable Housing Management Association (JAHMA).

In the winter of 2021, our staff at Harriet Bryan House and Elm Court - PCH's senior affordable housing communities - organized a Covid-19 Vaccine clinic for the senior residents and staff.

Information was directly delivered to residents' door pockets and flyers were hung throughout the buildings. The staff also communicated with family members to ensure that residents knew how to sign up to receive the Covid-19 Vaccine. Because of their hard work and extraordinary efforts, 164 residents and staff members were vaccinated at Harriet Bryan House and Elm Court.

PCH also worked with the Princeton Health Department to offer on-site Covid-19 and Flu Vaccination clinics at Princeton Community Village. In addition, PCH's Social Services Coordinators continued to provide information about other local vaccine clinics and testing sites, as well as access to food donations for residents in need through YMCA Princeton, Jewish Family and Children Service of Mercer County, Arm and Arm, Stone Hill Church, and the Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Programs.
